Peter was the son of George and Sarah (nee hale) Riddle of Floyd Co., Kentucky. His father Peter was the brother to John Riddle who established Riddle Hill after purchasing it from Dr. Given Owen. See Note #1 RIDDLE, Safronia Jane Tompkins-Riddle was born November 1854 in Stoddard or Dunklin Co., Mo. She was the daughter of Carney and
